Although children grow and learn at different paces, there is usually an order and timeline that most follow as indicated in Developmental Milestones.

Families provide the foundation for young children to grow and learn. During the first three years of a child's life access to early intervention is vital to support the learning of a child who demonstrates any difficulty in meeting their developmental milestones.

If you are concerned about a child's development...

With parental consent, community services supporting family health or education may refer to an Early Intervention Provider service.

We encourage every person working in support of families to seek information from the range of Early Intervention Providers to extend their own knowledge in regard to the importance of early intervention. This will enable parents to be provided with the resources to make an informed personal choice of the service that best meets the needs of their child and their family.

Parents may contact our service directly to obtain information.

Conductive Education provides an educational based therapy, encompassing all areas of development. The programme is carried out within a continuous, concentrated way, meeting the child's learning needs alongside the needs of the family unit.

Conductive Education incorporates a physical approach to work toward building new movement patterns that underpin fine and gross motor skill functions.

Conductive Education Preschool offers a warm and colourful facility. We encourage a positive atmosphere, with the opportunity for all students to experience success.

Conductive Education is a fun educational approach, which is carried out through set daily activities. The frame of the programme is supported with motivation and rhythmical intention, which sets a tone and rhythm to movements. It is a planned, day-to-day programme of experiencing learning and participating. Each class is lead by a qualified Conductor. Learning goals are set after identifying the children's strengths, abilities and needs, taking under consideration their interests. In small, simple steps, the Conductor teaches the child to gain new skills they require to gain independence at their own level. They provide the child with the opportunities to actively participate in the programme rather than being acted upon.

Who can benefit from Conductive Education?

Conductive Education is contracted by the Ministry of Health for Child Development, Physical and Sensory.

- For children from birth to 6 years of age
- For children experiencing physical difficulties either as a diagnosis or symptom of a condition.

Our programme caters for a range of physical needs from mild to more involved issues with movement. Children may have additional learning, sensory or behavioral needs as a result of their primary diagnosis; these needs are also supported within our programme.

How can we support Educators?

Accredited by the Ministry of Education to provide Early Intervention, our qualified staff work to support the child and the family across different settings.

- Children identified as eligible for Paraprofessional Support may access an Education Support Worker to supplement their inclusion within an Early Childhood Education centre.
- Our staff can provide information, advice and guidance; our staff are available for consultation with parents or staff within your service.
- Tailored programme provided to meet learning skills; can be adapted to wider community setting
- Access to resources/equipment to support children's learning
